“Polam pilusthondi” Programmes in association with Dept. of Agriculture

RASS-Krishi Vigyan Kendra scientists participated in “Polam Pilusthondi” programmes at Thottambedu, Renigunta, KVB Puram mandals on 24.09.2024 and Srikalahasthi mandal on 25.09.2024 organized by Department of Agriculture.

Dr. S. Sreenivasulu, Senior Scientist and Head has attended Polam pilusthondi programme at Poyya and Singanamala villages of Thottambedu mandal, Melachur village of Srikalahasthi mandal and he explained about KVK activities towards different stakeholders in the district, green manure crops and importance of green manuring for soil health management, direct seeding methods of rice, suitable rice varieties for the region, Natural farming, soil and water conservation measures, integrated farming systems for sustainable agriculture and importance of nutigardens.

Padmaja, SMS, Sericulture has attended Polam pilusthondi programme at Gajulamandyam village of Renigunta mandal and she emphasised on importance of soil testing and soil sample collection in scientific method, soil test-based fertilizer application, seed treatment, organic farming, management practices in mulberry cultivation and silkworm rearing and subsidy schemes from department of sericulture etc.
